Summary of role

This role supports Technical Management in the planning and operation of all technical elements based at Fairfield Halls, ensuring that the highest standards are met and assisting with the organisation of the part-time and casual technical colleagues.

The Senior Technician is required to work closely with all incoming productions to ensure the safe get-in and get-out of all shows and events as well as the smooth running of performances. Additional payments will be made for get outs.

Key responsibilities

- To lead on the safe get-in, operation and get-out of all productions and events.
- Assist in the design, set up, management, and operation of events and productions as required by technical management, including, but not limited to Lighting, Staging, Sound and AV, and according to the requirements of the production or event.
- To liaise with productions and events as designated by the Technical Management.
- Supply training to full time, part-time and casual colleagues to ensure the safe operation of all technical equipment and stage engineering equipment.
- Ensure all in-house equipment is in good order, suitably inspected and tested, and stored correctly.
- Oversee the use of work and storage areas ensuring that they are clean with good access and free of waste.
- Ensure that venue colleagues and touring production companies are compliant with the best practices and current legislations.
- To act as Duty Technician and key holder for Fairfield Halls.
- Ensuring safe working practices are understood and observed by all engaged in works, both within your areas and in the wider building
- To participate in any training sessions/seminars/exercises as required
- To attend meetings, site visits, rehearsals and production meetings as required.
- To communicate effectively within the Tech Opps team, and other departments within the business.
- To work flexibly and undertake such other duties as required within the general scope and grade of the post.
- This role involves manual handling, lifting and working at heights.
- This role involves shift work, working evenings, weekends, Bank holidays and late nights.
